

Quartz Installation Guide

Quartz tops are prefabricated and will be provided cut to size and ready for installation, unless otherwise specified. It is recommended to store tops indoors prior to installation.

Installation

- Prior to installation, ensure the correct vanity base and top have been placed in the space.
- Check that the vanity base has been securely fastened to the wall and is level.
- Carefully lift and place the quartz top on the vanity base, ensuring the top is level and has correct alignment.
- All tops are manufactured to allow for an overhang, consult drawing[s] for details.
- Never insert mechanical fasteners, such as nails and screws, into quartz, unless drawings specify otherwise.
- Use a silicone adhesive to secure the vanity top and backsplash[s]. Apply a bead of silicone along the edges of the vanity top where it meets the vanity base to create a flexible seal and prevent water penetration. Extra adhesive should be placed on all corners along the joints. Remove any excess material.
- Use a seam sealer to fill and seal any visible seams between the quartz top, side splash[s] and backsplash.
- Clean the top with a mild detergent and water to remove any dust or debris from the installation process.
